


When You Arrive

Look for the registration tables when you arrive! Registration begins at 1pm on Sunday of your camp week. We are so excited to see you! If you arrive early, please plan to supervise your child until 1pm. The adventure begins at 3pm so please register before then! Address and directions can be found <u>Here</u>!

Medical Information

It is recommended by WI State Code that campers have a physical within the last two years either through a doctor, or school athletic program.



All medication must be left with our Health Care staff at check-in. Any medication provided must be in its original container, clearly labeled with the camper's name, and directions for use or the prescription details.

At registration, it is up to you to inform our medical personnel if there have been any changes in your child's health condition since applying for camp.



Pictures and Video Policy

Each week we have a volunteer photographer that posts photos on Facebook so you can see the kids are up to during the week. If you do not wish to have your child photographed, notify the staff at registration if you did not already denote on your application.

Please be aware the photos may also be used by Camp Croix for promotional use.

Registration Fee

A \$100 deposit is required at registration. If you have not paid the deposit by April 1st your child may be removed from the reservation list to open the spot for a committed camper. We encourage you to pay online. Please plan to pay the balance of your camp fees by June 1st. If your balance is not paid in full, your spot may be forfeit to a camper on the waitlist.

Need to cancel?
